As promised at the August PC meeting, below is a schedule of outreach to the village on the policies of the NP.

### **Village News**

September deadline 2020 – Environmental Policies

November deadline 2021 - Housing Policies

January deadline 2021 – Community & Economy Policies

March deadline 2021 – Transport Policies

There are **key issues** in the Neighbourhood Plan such as housing, biodiversity, traffic calming, buses, village centre, upgrades to cycle & footpaths, re-instatement and maintenance of verges and technology. These issues are reflected in the range of Advisory Groups that report to the Parish Council. It is important to have a range of views reflected by the membership of these groups. The PC needs to be increasingly aware of villagers who could be involved in our work. Could councillors **please help** in this regard?

Once we are closer to having a date for the referendum, a leaflet will be circulated to villagers giving a summary of the Neighbourhood Plan and encouraging them to vote.

The final copy of the Neighbourhood Plan is being uploaded on the CDC site. A huge thanks to Susan Daenke who has braved the horrors of editing and produced a neat and accurate document which reflects both examiner's comments.

**Resolution:** That up to £200 be available from the NP budget line for printing a limited number of hard copies of the Neighbourhood Plan.

The number of copies is yet to be determined.
