Weston on the Green Traffic Calming Advisory Group

Minutes of the meeting of the Traffic Calming Advisory Group (TCAG) held on Monday April 7th at Mithian Cottage, Oxford Road, Weston on the Green.

1. <u>Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on November 13th 2024:</u> The minutes are considered an accurate record of the meeting.

2. Matters arising from the meeting:

The main discussion point was on the reduction in speed limit to 30mph on the B430. It was noted that the Parish Council have agreed with OCC to fund the administration costs involved but were not in a position to assist with funding signage etc.

There had been some concern about where the 30mph limit would begin and end but it is believed to exactly replicate the current 40mph limit.

MA and GB will walk the village to identify required signage.

Reduction in speed limit expected to happen in next few months.

LT has provided costings for a range of speed indicator signs which were reviewed and discussed referencing signs at Middleton Stoney and at Lower Heyford.

DB and MA having met with a representative from Middleton Stoney.

Middleton Stoney PC are understood to have a Freedom of Information document stating that the B430 is not an official relief route for the M40, DB to try to obtain a copy.

DB will make contact with Lower Heyford Parish Council to arrange discussion on costs and logistics for their portable signage which was considered to be most appropriate for us.

DB updated the meeting on potential S106 money from the Southfield development but that may not be accessible until the development is formally adopted.

The Parish Council will also contact Tritax Symmetry to investigate potential funding for traffic calming measures.

3. Bridge over the A34

It was noted that the subsidence appears to be getting gradually worse.
