Weston towards Oddington

A 6.5 mile circular walk from Weston towards Oddington beginning and ending on the Oxfordshire Way

Leaving Weston from wherever you are, walk down to A34 flyover and turn right onto Wendlebury road and immediately right again to take the track down towards Oddington Grange, on the last long straight stretch before the Grange, just after the white concrete marker, turn right onto Oxfordshire Way footpath. This Is not actually waymarked but the footpath should be visible.

Follow path across the field to a kissing gate, bear right following Oxfordshire Way to kissing gate and footbridge in the hedge, continue straight ahead, still following Oxfordshire Way to far right hand corner of field.

Follow narrow path through hedgeway with paddock on your left, into open field and continue along left hand edge to kissing gate in left hand corner, continue through gate over footbridge and out onto a farm track, turn right and then left at end of left hand hedge.

Continue down left hand edge of field, still on Oxfordshire Way, past the log pile and take the second open gateway on the left to continue on the other side of the hedge.

Continue down field, with hedge on your right, past a kissing gate on right hand side, to a kissing gate in far right hand corner of field, with railway line ahead of you.

Go through kissing gate and follow path to footbridge over railway line, cross this footbridge and leave the Oxfordshire Way here by turning immediately left to follow railway line to the end of the first field.

Turn right and follow the broken hedgeline into the next field and continue over two footbridges and out into a field, follow the waymarked footpath slightly diagonally right and out onto Islip road.

Carefully turn left and follow the road for 70 yards to turning signposted for Charlton on Otmoor and Oddington.

If you are feeling particularly energetic you could turn right here to go through Oddington and out Into RSPB Otmoor.

Otherwise turn left into the narrow road, opposite turn to Oddington, follow this road up and over the railway bridge and on towards a house on right hand side.

Opposite this house turn left through a gate into the field and follow the footpath with hedge on your left, then bearing diagonally right towards the kissing gate in fence on right hand side of field. You should recognise this gate as the one you came through earlier on, so go back across the field, on the Oxfordshire Way, to Oddington Grange track, turning left to return to the village.
