The Customer Relations Advisor has now contacted that depot to arrange it and following a further enquiry by me they have chased the depot again for a date.

### 7. Layby Waste on Northampton Road by Old Flight House

A nearby resident to the layby close to the Flight House on Northampton Road complained about rubbish being left by the layby and the bins having been removed. This was reported to Cherwell District Council and the Environment Enforcement Officer confirmed that they will organise for the rubbish to be cleared up.

He reported that the bins have been removed by persons unknown and this is not the first time this has occurred, the units where the bins were located also kept getting damaged. Due to the cost of repair and replacement Cherwell District Council has been decided not to replace the bins.
