The balance on the Parish Council two bank accounts on 17th February 2023 were:

4. Oxfordshire County Council Highways Update on Works

- Village potholes identified: fixed but continue to monitor given likely to continue to degrade with weather.
- Westlands Avenue footpath: OCC have contacted Punch to advise them of the requirement to clear the vegetation growing from the Ben Jonson garden. Punch have advised that contractors should be at the site in early March to carry out the work. This will be monitored and the Highways Inspector kept informed in case it is not completed.
The moss and overgrown brambles on the pavement itself have also been reported to Cherwell District Council but no action has been taken as yet.
- North Lane broken drain: this has also been worked and will monitor with heavy rainfall to check it was successful.
- Manhole cover to rear of North Lane: still to be fixed.
- Utility (BT) cover on B430 pavement between Manor Farm and Knowle Lane: highlighted to OCC who have contacted BT for fixing. BT are waiting for a new cover and should be fitted in the next couple of weeks. Traffic cones over the hole to keep it safe.

5. SSE Sub-Station, B430 Waste Update

The waste left by SSE contractors has now been cleared.

6. Traffic Calming – Wheelie Bin Stickers

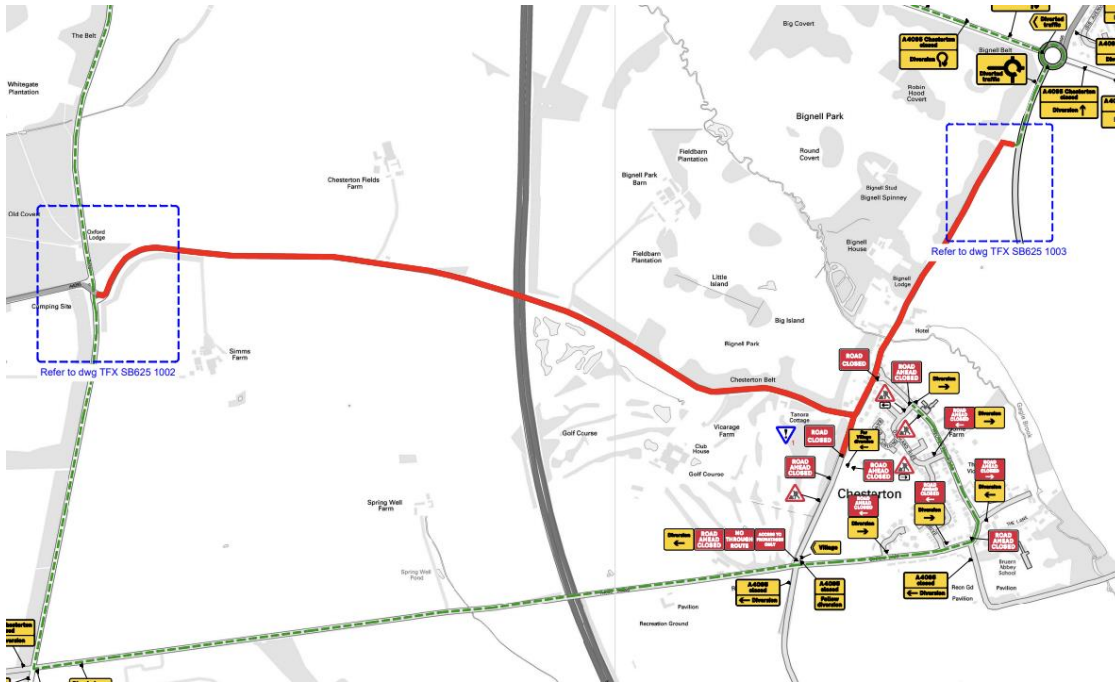
Traffic speed safety stickers for wheelie bins have been delivered to Church Road and Church Lane residents with a covering letter. This is to raise awareness of the 20mph speed limit through the centre of the village and to support the work being done by the Community Speedwatch team.

7. Village Hall Thank You Card

The Village Hall Committee has kindly sent a thank you King Coronation card to thank the Parish Council for the kind donation towards the afternoon tea event, which has enabled them to make it a free event for villagers.

8. Notice of Road Closure

OCC have advised of a road closure to a section of A4095 Kirtlington Road whilst essential S278 highway works and installation of new service for the Great Wolf Lodge development works.



The temporary closure will operate from 24th April 2023 up to and including 21st July 2023. This is a 24 hour road closure.
